lost contact with my Dad and had many family problems so it gave me time to forget my problems. I started to really try and school and wanted to get into Bishop Burton to study Equine Management which I am now doing!

I am now a star pupil and study hard, my Mum says I am a changed person. I now respect people, have ambitions and realise it is a big world out there. Being around horses, so big, lovable and powerful has changed my life and thank to the Emile Faurie Foundation I can look forward to a bright future.

Rachel has just passed her BHS Stage I and is working towards her Stage 2. She is going to University to study Equine Degree Course.All of this she would never of been able to achieve without the support of the Foundation!

Rachel was given an Achievement Award by Ryders Farm and also received a photo of Emile competing and a Special Rosette and invite to visit Emile's yard. Rachel was thrilled and looking forward to meeting her role model!
